



## TTA'S ROAD MAP TO FUN (THE RULES):

We guarantee a great time for all of our TTA Teens; however, our journeys are structured such that a cooperative team effort is required from everyone on the trip. Additionally, because we care about the health, safety and general welfare of our TTA family, we have a few rules and regulations with which you must comply:

1. **DO NOT** participate in the use or possession of alcohol, drugs, paraphernalia, or tobacco products.
2. **DO NOT** participate in any illegal activities, such as vandalism, theft, shoplifting, or other criminal acts.
3. **DO NOT** pick on or otherwise harass your fellow travelers, including counselors, other teens, bus drivers, or any other guest/tour guide of TTA.
4. **DO NOT** ignore instructions or rules provided by the TTA counselors, including curfews and all other safety regulations.
5. **DO NOT** leave your hotel, condo, or dorm room or any area or program without prior permission or instruction from your TTA counselors.

While it is unpleasant to think that you might violate any of the above rules, or any other rules established by your tour leader, you must remember that any such violation **WILL** result in your being sent home from the trip. All action taken in this regard, including the manner of your transportation home, will be at the **SOLE DISCRETION** of TTA. In addition, you and/or your parents will be responsible for the full cost of your trip home and **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED**.

## SOME OTHER STUFF:

1. On rare occasions, we may choose to alter plans in the event of inclement weather, activity cancellation, or other unforeseen circumstances. In all cases, suitable replacement activities will be selected.
2. TTA cannot accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury resulting from delay or negligence of any of TTA's purveyors or vendors. TTA acts in the best interest of all its teens in connection with safety during activities, inclement weather and at any of its accommodation locations; however, TTA cannot be held liable for any inherent risks with regard to weather, accidents, illness and other occurrences beyond the reasonable control of TTA during the course of the program. All participants and parents agree they have acknowledged and accepted these risks.
3. In any case of illness, TTA will seek appropriate medical assistance as outlined in the **TTA MEDICAL FORM**. All teens must have suitable medical insurance to cover all medical costs. The full cost of medical care' including but not limited to, transportation to and from medical facilities, treatment not covered by your own insurance and any necessary medical supplies, must be paid by you and/or your parents.
4. Take care of your property, such as MP3 players, clothing and other valuables you bring with you, as TTA will not be held responsible under any circumstances whatsoever if they are lost or damaged.
5. TTA may use photographs, videotapes and testimonials of participants in publicity materials.

**Tuition deposits paid to TTA are fully refundable until May 1, 2009. Cancellation after May 1, 2009 but prior to departure date will result in a \$1,000 cancellation fee. Airline tickets purchased are non-refundable.**
